Gaps identified during V2 fishery assessment

Similar or identical to V1.6 improvements already in IFFO RS IP improvement timeline:

- a. M2.3 Provide additional evidence of the efficacy of the control and enforcement regime.
- b. A2.1 (anchoveta & thread herring) Continue to conduct regular stock assessments
- c. A2.1 (thread herring) Conduct a study to determine what species of thread herring are present in the catch, and in what ratios.
- d. A2.2 (anchoveta & thread herring) Determine a reference point or proxy for the stocks.
- e. A3.2 (anchoveta & thread herring) Ensure total removals do not exceed the level indicated as appropriate by stock assessments.
- f. F1.2 Provide evidence that the fishery does not have a significant negative impact on ETP species, particularly scalloped hammerhead.
- g. F1.3 Provide evidence of measures in place to reduce the impact of the fishery on ETP species, particularly turtles and elasmobranchs.

New as a result of V2 changes:

- h. A2.4 (anchoveta & thread herring) Provide evidence of the peer review process for stock assessments.
- i. A3.3 (anchoveta & thread herring) Establish a limit reference point for each stock, below which the commercial fishery will be suspended.
- j. D1 (Cachema weakfish, Peruvian moonfish) Provide additional PSA information. Not essential to achieve an overall Pass.
- k. D1 (Sea catfish) Establish additional PSA information OR take steps to meet the requirements of Table D4. Required to achieve an overall Pass.
- I. F3.1 Provide evidence of consideration of the broader ecosystem during the management process.
- m. F3.2 Ensure that any potentially significant negative impacts of the fishery on the ecosystem are mitigated.

n. F3.3 – Determine whether anchoveta, thread herring, or bumper play a key role in the ecosystem, and factor the results into the management process.
